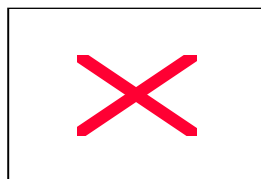

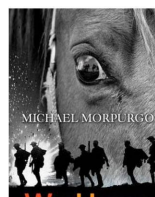
### OTHER NEWS
