Sports Premium Grant Statement 2017/18
<p>Our vision is that all pupils leaving St. Gabriel's will be physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.</p> <p>Our objective is to achieve a self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools against the following five key indicators:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles2. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils5. Increased participation in competitive sport <p><u>Outline of provision</u></p> <p>We will use our PE and Sports Premium funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport that we offer by developing and adding to the PE and sport activities that our school already offers.</p> <p>In addition to this we will make improvements that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• hiring qualified sports coaches to work with and alongside teachers.• providing existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively.• introducing new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport.• supporting and involving the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs.• running sport competitions within school.• increasing pupils' participation in the School Games.• running sports activities with other schools.
