Welcome back to all of our children starting the new school year and a special welcome to all of our new children in the Reception class and families new to St Gabriel's CE Primary School.

Miss Wilkinson has joined our office team and will be working alongside Mrs Hollings and Mrs Howarth.

<u>Change to Junior playtimes</u>— Please note, after much consideration, we have decided to remove the timetabled afternoon playtime for Junior children. This is for several reasons, but it allows us to maintain the flow of lessons and create extra opportunities for reading-children reading for themselves, being heard read and listening to stories at the end of the day.
