In our Literacy and Language work we will begin the term with a close look at Legends. We will write our own.

READING - There is no doubt that readers find writing easier as they have a greater bank of ideas from the stories they have read. Reading also aids spelling as you see the words more

often and are therefore more likely to spot mistakes in your own spelling. It also enriches your vocabulary as you learn new words and phrases, which paint vivid pictures in your mind.

spelling - The children will be taught spellings through a new systematic spelling programme Read Write Inc. Spelling. This will enable them to spell new words correctly and give them plenty of practice in spelling these new words, including exception words and homophones. The

children will bring home the spellings that they have been learning in a spelling log book and they will be encouraged to share these at home with you.
