I would like to clearly state that it is always our intention to keep school open as far as is reasonably possible. Unfortunately, achieving required staffing levels by 9:00 a.m. is always a concern and is a major reason for school closures throughout the country. As traffic delays are the obvious issues, we feel that a full closure could be avoided by arranging a delayed opening. In the event of snow and the likelihood of disruption, we will aim to **text all parents at approximately 8:15 a.m.** to advise that school is either:



Closed (in the case of severe snow)

Delaying opening until given time e.g. 10:30 a.m. (in the case of light snow, but severe traffic issues.

If there is no text assume school is open
