Uniform

As it gets warmer the children like to take off their jumpers or cardigans, could I please ask you to check that your child's name is clearly labelled. Otherwise it makes it very difficult to match up jumpers/cardigans to the correct child at the end of the day.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check.

In Year 1 it is a national requirement that your child completes a phonics screening check where they are required to read a range of real and nonsense words using all the set 2 and 3 phonic sounds they've been taught through Read, Write, Inc. This is nothing new to your child as we do this everyday as part of our 'speed sounds' session in phonics so there is nothing to worry about. I know all the children are well prepared for this phonics check but I will send home some reading booklets over the next few weeks to help familiarise your child with the format of the phonics check. I will carry out the phonics screening week commencing the 10th of June.

Parental Support

Thank you for all the support you give your child already. Please continue to read regularly at home, little and often is best. Sharing their library book that they've chosen is invaluable too, especially when time is given to talk about the book, new vocabulary and their likes/dislikes.

Home Learning

Mental Maths

Each week at the beginning of our daily Maths lessons some time is spent recalling, using and applying our number bonds. We will also be counting back in different step sizes, doubling and halving numbers. Any extra practice at home would be great!

Reading

Please try to read your child's book more than once as this really does benefit their fluency and understanding.

Spellings

Last term the children achieved great results from their spellings. This term's focus will be linked to their phonics and we will be learning words with the same sound but different ways of spelling it. For example: ay can be also spelt using al, a-e.
