Reading for pleasure

How you can help your child learning this year

Year 2 is an important year for learning; it is the year when children should become competent and confident in all areas, but particularly in reading, writing and maths. To ensure that the children become the best that they can be, please support them to do their home learning online. Listen to your child read at home, talk about the books they have read at school, help them with any English or Maths tasks, share and practise weekly spellings and learn the number bonds to 20 and times tables facts as and when they have been sent home.

Maths

We want to do as much as possible to support your child to recap essential content that they may have forgotten or not have covered during the school closure period. So we will be providing a blended maths curriculum which will revisit and embed prior learning as well introducing new concepts.
