

Class 'Bubble' Closure

Please do not assume that children who are self-isolating (in their own household or because their class is closed) will automatically return on the given date after 10 days.

They are self-isolating because they are at risk of developing Covid.

Therefore, you must ensure that they have NO SYMPTOMS before they return.

The diagram below explains how self-isolation works for different family members.

Please note: self-isolation is now for **10 days, not 14**, counting the first day of symptoms as day 0.
