## Welcome to Year Six

### ENGLISH

#### WRITING

In our Literacy and Language work we will begin the term with a close look at Legends. We will write our own.

We will also look at poetry, journalistic writing as well as having a go at writing longer stories and of course there will be lots of reading and writing in other subjects.

**READING** - There is no doubt that readers find writing easier as they have a greater bank of ideas from the stories they have read. Reading also aids spelling as you see the words more of-

ten and are therefore more likely to spot mistakes in your own spelling. It also enriches your vocabulary as you learn new words and phrases, which paint vivid pictures in your mind.

**SPELLING** - The children will be taught spellings through a new systematic spelling programme Read Write Inc. Spelling. This will enable them to spell new words correctly and give them plenty of practice in spelling these new words, including exception words and homophones. The chil-

dren will bring home the spellings that they have been learning in a spelling log book and they will be encouraged to share these at home with you.

### MATHEMATICS

We will look at ....Number and place value, fractions, algebra, Angles and Nets...Phew! If you have any questions at all regarding maths or your child's maths homework please ask.

### GEOGRAPHY & SCIENCE

We will be considering how animals and people adapt to their environments. In Science we will be exploring adaptation and survival of the fittest and in Geography we will be researching the world's countries and their key features.
