## Test and Trace over Easter Holiday

If your child is in school up to and including Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March and then **presents with Covid symptoms** <u>**before 3.30pm on Sunday 28**<sup>th</sup> <u>**March**</u>, and later **tests positive**, they will send the staff and children in their class into self-isolation for 10 days. This is because your child was in contact with their class bubble within the 48 hour infectious period prior to their symptoms starting.</u>

If this situation arises, please:

• Email the school office (<u>office@stgabriels.blackburn.sch.uk</u>) **no later than Sunday evening**, to inform of us that your child has symptoms <u>and that you have/or will be arranging a test.</u>

Then...

• Email the office **ASAP when you have your NHS result** (whether positive or negative).

Please also note:

If your child develops symptoms at any point AFTER 3.30pm on Sunday 28th March, you should:

- Arrange a test.
- Advise school (office@stgabriels.blackburn.sch.uk)
- The National test and trace service will give you the dates for your household to isolate (and a return to school date if applicable).

We hope your child / children will return to school on <u>Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April</u>, but once again, please be mindful that **if your children have any Covid symptoms**, they should not come back to school, but should get a test.

**Reminder:** school is now OPEN on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April, but will be closed on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> June.
