Snowy Weather*:

It is always our intention to keep school open as far as is reasonably possible. Unfortunately, achieving required staffing levels by 9.00 a.m. is always a concern and is a major reason for school closures throughout the country. As traffic delays are the obvious issues, a delayed opening is sometimes arranged to avoid full school closure. In the event of snow and the likelihood of disruption, we aim to text all parents at approximately 8.15 a.m. and advise them that school is either:





Closed (in the case of severe snow)



Delaying opening until a given time e.g. 10:30 a.m. (in the case of light snow, but severe traffic issues).



If there is no text assume that school is open.

Note: We will **NOT** be using the local radio services to advise of closure or delayed opening.
