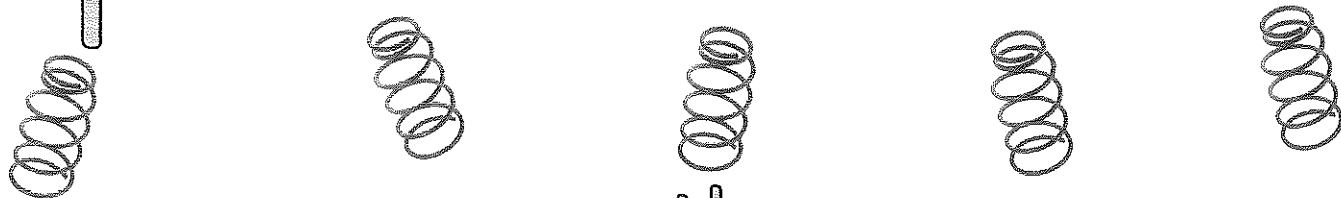

With the funds raised we hope to purchase a defibrillator for school.



In the event of a sudden cardiac arrest a defibrillator can deliver an electrical current through the chest which aims to shock the heart back into a normal rhythm allowing it to pump again.

If such an unfortunate event was to happen to either an adult or child within school, then the defibrillator could be used to deal with the emergency in the best way possible. Current research suggests that survival chances with CPR alone is only 5%, whereas it increases to 50% with defibrillation.

Any extra monies raised, after purchase of the defibrillator, will be donated to Sport Relief which raises funds to transform lives here in the UK, and also to fund projects in the world's poorest communities.
