



## What can you do to help your child stay safe? Children Parents

Share what you are doing with your parents.

- •Think about the information you put online, it could affect your life later on.
- •Think before you click.
- Consider how you speak to people online
   Set privacy settings.
- Delete any friends you don't know.
- Never use a webcam or video chat when talking online unless your parents say you can.
- •Keep evidence
- Do not meet people you met online unless you go with a trusted adult
- Ask children to show you what they are doing.
- •Find out what your children are sharing online.
- Ask about their online friends and how they know them.
- Set family friendly controls
- Check your own privacy settings
- ·Be a role model
