St. Gabriel's School is taking part in the BwD Healthy Travel to

School Promotion. We hope that as many families as possible will travel to school in a healthy and sustainable way. The modes of transport we would like to encourage are walking, cycling, car-sharing or travelling on public transport. If it is essential to travel by car, to support the promotion, please consider parking the car a short distance from school on the Knowles Arms car park and walking the rest of the way. In order to participate in this promotion you must not park or drop off in Wilworth Crescent. We have gained permission to use the car park at the Knowles Arms as a park and stride facility. If you live in the vicinity, please leave the car at home and walk. The children are encouraged to walk a short distance to be healthier and to highlight positive road safety practices. Children who do not participate in the promotion will not receive their certificates or be able to take part in the prize draw. There should be no cars at all near the school during this promotional week.

Children will be given a passport and it will be stamped every time they walk or cycle into school, even part of the way, as they go through passport control at school. There will be a presentation assembly when certificates will be given to all children who have participated correctly in the promotion and there will be a prize draw with all the completed passports.

<u>Harvest Appeal</u> – Our worship 'Beacons' will be announcing this appeal in school next week. We will, once again, be supporting Blackburn Foodbank and ask each class to bring something different (details next week) into school on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October for our special Harvest Worship Assembly. This will be led by Year 1 and Year 1 parents will also be invited to attend.

<u>School Health Needs Assessment</u> – This year the school will be taking part again in the School Health Needs Assessment (SHNA) in partnership with the school nurse teams from Lancashire Care NHS Foundation Trust. This helps us to better understand and respond to the health and well-being needs of children in the school and also for extra support to be given if needed. If your child is in Reception or Year 6 you will be asked to complete a questionnaire. Children in Year 6 will also complete one in class. The majority of schools in Lancashire are involved in this and last year over 30,000 children and parents took part! If you would like to know more about this the school nurse will be happy to tell you more.
