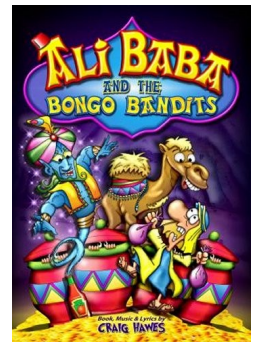

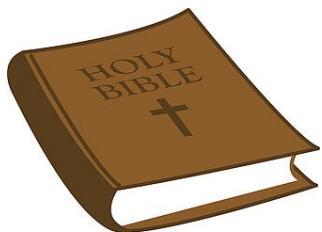
End of Year Reports will be sent out on Monday 18th July. If you have any queries, please contact school and arrange to see your class teacher.
