

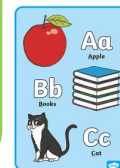
Skills that will help your child to become 'school ready'

Say when I need help

Follow instructions

Sing familiar nursery rhymes and songs

Join in with repeated phrases in stories e.g. 'Run, run, as fast as you can...'



Wait for my turn when talking and have a back and forth conversation

Sit quietly when asked

Turn pages in books



Share my toys



Take turns when playing games



Recognise my own name

Hear and identify the first sounds in words including my name



Listen when others talk

Introduce myself

Sit and listen to a story



Talk about my favorite stories and characters



Know the parts of my body and what they are used for



Walk, run, hop, jump and skip

Hold a pencil and make marks that represent objects, people and living things using shapes e.g. circle for face

Talk about what I have drawn/created



Climb stairs and playground equipment

Hold a pair of scissors and make snips in paper



Begin to colour within a shape

Build and create by joining objects together e.g. lego

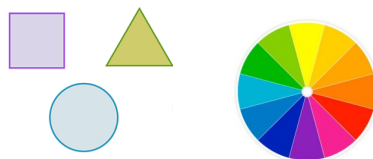
Talk about/identify the weather and natural objects

Kick, throw and sometimes catch a ball

Know basic colours and shapes



Use words to compare e.g. bigger, heavier, more, less



Sort objects by colour, shape and size

Count up to 5 objects



Recognise some numerals

Get 1, 2 and 3 objects when prompted

Talk about my family, my home, special people and places
