You may recall that early in December The Beacons decided to raise money to support the children of 'Hope of Life', a school in Guatemala. For those who don't know much about 'Hope of Life' (Esperanza de Vida) it's a school that gives children, from very poor families,

the opportunity to have an education and a chance of changing their lives, long term, for a better future. Here at St Gabriel's, over several years, we have had the opportunity to learn about the children who have attended this school and our Beacons have always been keen to keep these children in their thoughts and prayers and support them in any way they can. We see 'Hope of Life' as our sister school.



The Beacons chose to run a Christmas tuck shop and children kindly donated £1 in exchange for some

tasty chocolate treats. The money raised, which was a fantastic £225, has been sent to Guatemala and this will be used for a celebration event for their children sometime early this year.

What was even more exciting was that the director of 'Hope of Life', Juan Manuel and his wife Rosa were actually able to visit St Gabriel's before Christmas! I know some parents have already heard from their children about this visit and how they had learnt to say a few words in Spanish to be able to say 'hello' and 'welcome'.
