Leavers and Presentation of Awards Service – Thursday 20th July @ 9.30

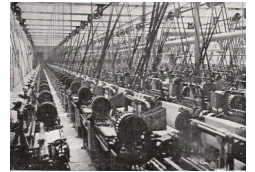
