<u>Essential Information for Parents</u> I would like to take this opportunity, at the beginning of the new school year, to clarify a number of school policies and procedures, many of which relate to the health and safety issues which are becoming increasingly important. Please see the 'Essential Information for Parents' document that has been uploaded to our website under 'Information'.





<u>Class Information for Parents</u> Class Information for all parents is available to view on the website for each class under 'Classes'. It contains information specific to each class detailing topics of work covered this term, along with details of homework and P.E. days.

<u>Attendance</u> Attendance and the number of late arrivals is monitored closely in school. Our school's target attendance is 95% and above. When attendance falls below 90% this is officially classed as a 'cause for concern'. Please make every effort to ensure your child maximises every day in school. Parents taking holidays during term time will be fined (in accordance with our Absence Policy).



Dinner Money— For those who pay for school dinners the price is £2.20 per meal. Please note, our school dinner requirements are that dinners should be paid weekly or if preferred, termly in advance.

There is a lot of administration time that goes into setting up the new dinner choices at the beginning of the school year. We ask that you try and stick to these choices. If you wish to move your child from packed lunches to school dinners or from school dinners to packed lunches we require a weeks' notice for these changes to be put in place.

Parking around School—Wilworth crescent has an unofficial one-way system during school hours. We ask that parents do not stop in the road to drop children off, pull up on the zig zag lines or block residents' driveways.
