



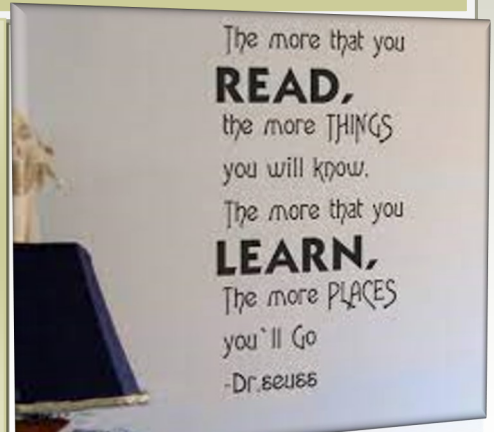
Year Six Summer Newsletter 2026
