

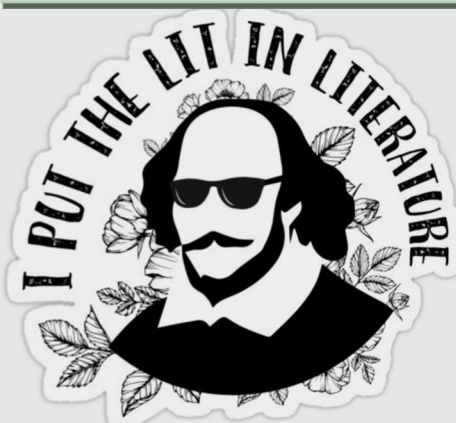


Year Six Spring Newsletter 2026
